

### Collaboration with the private sector

- In 2006 PA introduced a fee for-service training package, tailored mentoring and dialogue facilitation sessions,
- Since that time PA have regular service contracts with various companies, particularly banks and telecommunication companies, assisting around 2000 employees by driving the workforce performances and inspiring a culture of lifelong learning.



"Green Business Competition" – supporting new green initiatives that use local resources and revitalizing traditions of production and local markets.

- Financial support a combination of philanthropic institutions and business contributions (in-cash & in-kind).
- Support scheme includes coaching and training for SEs provided by businesses in the form of pro-bono assistance.



- Building trust, partnerships and accountable CSOs
- 281 participants attended the seven events 2017 – 2021.
- Participation of 116 CSOs, 40 businesses, and 6 public institutions.
- Wide geographic coverage Tirana, Durres, Korçë, Shkodër, Vlore and Elbasan municipalities.
- 10 businesses offer pro-bono assistance in terms of marketing of products, business contract and reporting at state authorities.

#### **GIVING CIRCLE EVENTS**

- ❖ Live Crowdfunding event 2 rounds (TFN Model)
- Bring individuals together to learn about community issues and solutions.
- **Collective funds** to make a difference.
- Supported 6 community led actions by CSOs (children with special needs, better public and school infrastructure, support youth integration and education of Roma and Egyptian children of their rights through sport).
- Increased almost three times the expected amount (EUR 41,000 while expected amount was EUR 15,000)

## CSOs – Businesses PARTNERSHIP EXAMPLES
